

Potawatomi Poker Room High Hand Promotion

Friday & Saturday

Eligibility / How to Enter

- All guests must be members of the Potawatomi Rewards Club (“PRC”) at the time of entry.
- Guests must be in a promotions eligible live action Texas Hold’em game.
 - A promotions eligible game is one that extracts a promotional dollar when the pot reaches a minimum of \$15 and a second promotional dollar when the pot reaches \$60
- Any high-ranking poker hand achieved by a FKC member playing in a live Texas Hold’em game during each qualifying session will have his/her hand recorded on the board. *A Full House Jacks full of Tens to qualify.*
- Any new high hand must beat - *Not Tie* – the previous high hand.
- In the event of a royal flush being the high hand, a \$500 bonus will be awarded.
- PRC Members are eligible to win more than once per promotion date
- Management reserves the right to suspend or modify the promotion at any time.

How it works

- Entrants must be present to win.
- There must be at least four players dealt into the hand and a minimum of \$15 in the pot to qualify.
- Qualifying “High Hand” must have both hole cards play and be the highest possible hand that can be made.
- High hands must be verified by the dealer and a floor person.
- “High Hand” Name and Qualifying “High Hand” will be posted in the Poker Room
- “High Hand” holder must be playing in a promotions eligible Texas Hold’em game to win at the end of each session.
- Each segment will be worth \$100.
 - The prize for any segment that does not have a qualifying high hand will be returned to the jackpot fund.
- Promotion will end for that day after the 11pm - 11:59pm session.

- Qualifying “High Hand” holders are eligible to win multiple sessions.
- Any hand shown before action is complete or any player purposely stalling will be disqualified for the promotion.
- “Friday/Saturday High Hands” means: Qualifying high-ranking poker hand that is the highest-ranking hand made for the segment.
 - Jacks full of Tens (JJJ 10 10) is the minimum qualifying hand.
 - Both the player’s hole cards must play.
 - Hole cards must beat the board. If there is a tie, the board plays.
 - Example – If a player holds AK on a board that reads AAKKx, that hand would not qualify.
 - The prize for winning a segment is \$100.
- If a guest wins multiple segments in a single calendar day, their prize will be multiplied by the number of segments they have won.
 - Example – A guest has the highest hand during the 1am – 1:29am segment on Friday and then also wins the 2:30am – 2:59am segment. Their winnings for the 2:30 – 2:59am segment would be multiplied by 2, because it is their second win for the calendar day.
 - Example – If a guest wins the 10pm – 10:29pm segment on Friday, then the 1:30am – 1:59am segment on Saturday, the second segment would not have a multiplier because it happened on a different calendar day.
 - The multiplier only applies to the segment prize, not the royal flush bonus prize.
