Official Rules

1. Eligibility.

Club 50 Senior Day Kiosk Game is open to those fifty (50) years of age or older at the time of entry and must not be listed in the Potawatomi Casino | Hotel Banned Patron List. Must have a valid Players Club card to enter; membership is free. Employees of Potawatomi Casino | Hotel (“PCH”) are not eligible to participate in the Promotion.

2. Agreement to Official Rules.

By participating in the Promotion, entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of PCH, which are final and binding in all matters related to the promotion.

3. Promotion Period.

Promotion is valid at the Milwaukee Location only.

The Promotion period starts at 9:00 a.m. Central Time (CT), and ends at 11:59 p.m. (CT) each Wednesday during the months of April, May & June, 2026.

PCH’s computer is the official time-keeping device for this Promotion.

4. How to Enter.

All Players Club members fifty (50) years or older may play the **Club 50 Senior Day Kiosk Game**, after earning 200 same-day tier credits during the hours from 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m., guests can then swipe their Players Club card into any promotional kiosk, enter their PIN, select Monthly Promotions and then touch “Club 50”. Guests can participate up to 5 times each Wednesday. The Club 50 Senior Day Kiosk Game is available from 9 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. each Wednesday. No mechanically reproduced entries will be permitted. All entries become the property of PCH and will not be returned. Eligible guests that sign up for a Players Club card will be eligible to participate that same day.

5. Free Entry.

7. Drawing and Notification.

After earning 200 same-day tier credits during the hours from 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m.; guests can play the Club 50 Senior Day Kiosk Game and win Reward Play up to 5 times each Wednesday for every 200 same-day tier credits earned that day. The Club 50 Senior Day Kiosk Game will be available from 9:00 a.m. to 11:59 p.m. Guests can go to any promotional kiosk, swipe their card, enter their PIN, select Monthly Promotions and then touch “Club 50”. Reward Play is valid for 24 hours after redemption. PCH has the sole authority to determine the winners and such decisions are final.

8. Prize Acceptance/Restrictions.

Potential winners must comply with all terms and conditions of these Official Rules. Winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. The winners may be required to provide valid picture identification and Players Club card to claim prize. Prizes are not transferrable or assignable. No substitution allowed except by PCH, who may substitute a prize of equal or greater value if advertised prizes become unavailable. If any potential winner cannot be contacted, or fails to sign the required documents within the required time period, they forfeit prize.

9. Release, Publicity, Use of Personal Information.

Winners may be asked to allow use of their name and likeness for promotions/advertising purposes and announcements. If granted, an additional waiver, or Photo Release, will be filled out.

10. General Conditions.

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Promotion is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to, fraud, technical failures, regularly scheduled maintenance, virus or other technical problem, PCH may, in its sole discretion, either: (a) suspend the Promotion to address the impairment and then resume the Promotion in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules; or (b) cancel the Promotion and award the prizes in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received up to the time of impairment. PCH reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Promotion or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to undermine the legitimate operation of the Promotion may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and should an attempt be made, PCH reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent of the law. PCH’s failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. **Management reserves all rights to change or cancel this promotion at any time without notice.**
